

PCORI Fees Due July 31

Effective for plan years ending on or after October 1, 2012, and before October 1, 2019, employers that sponsor certain self-insured health plans are responsible for Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Institute (PCORI) fees. **Fees for plan years that ended in 2017 are due July 31, 2018.**

How to Pay PCORI Fees

Employers that sponsor [certain self-insured health plans](#) must report and pay the required PCORI fees via IRS [Form 720](#), *Quarterly Federal Excise Tax Return*.

- For plan years ending **between January 1, 2017 and September 30, 2017**, the fee for an employer sponsoring an applicable self-insured plan is \$2.26 multiplied by the average number of lives covered under the plan.
- For plan years ending **between October 1, 2017 and December 31, 2017**, the fee is \$2.39 multiplied by the average number of lives covered under the plan.
