

IRS Decreases 2018 HSA Contribution Limit for Certain Individuals

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) has announced that the 2018 annual limitation on health savings account (HSA) contributions by **individuals with family coverage under a high deductible health plan (HDHP)** is now **\$6,850**. This limit was previously announced as \$6,900, but has been revised downward due to an inflation adjustment provision in the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act. The 2018 annual limitation on HSA contributions by an individual with self-only coverage under an HDHP remains **unchanged at \$3,450**.
