

\$6,900 Re-Established as 2018 HSA Contribution Limit for Certain Individuals

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) has re-established **\$6,900** as the 2018 health savings account (HSA) contribution limit for **individuals with family coverage under a high deductible health plan (HDHP)**. This limit was previously announced as \$6,900 in May 2017, but was revised to \$6,850 in March 2018 due to an inflation adjustment provision in the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act.

The 2018 health savings account (HSA) contribution limit for individuals with self-only coverage under a HDHP remains **unchanged at \$3,450**.
